- 1. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

I. Special conditions of Contract (SCC):

- (1) Transportation of Domestic Goods/ services: The transportation of goods/services to be procured will be done by the supplier on FOR ISP Basis. The total cost of the transportation should also be indicated in the price bid of the item to be procured.
- **(2) Insurance:** A specific insurance cover for each consignment / supply is to be given by the firm, as applicable.
- **(3) Option Clause:** The Purchaser reserve the right to increase the ordered quantity in terms of period and amount by 25% at any time, till final delivery date of the contract, by giving reasonable notice even

though the quantity ordered initially has been supplied in full before the last date of the delivery period.

Note: The 'Experience and Past experience criteria' is exempted for Startups and Micro and Small Enterprises.

9. Past Project Experience

Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause: For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
