1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.

2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant /

Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. 6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have guoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. 1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

A. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

1. Experience: The bidder firm should have in Manufactured and/or supplied at least 50 Roll/400 Kg of s imilar type of "Plain White Nylon Plastic Strapping Roll" in any one year during last five year s i.e. from 01st April 2017 to 31st March 2022.

Note: Start-ups and Micro and small Enterprises are exempted from Experience and Past Performance crit eria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporti ng documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

2. Capability, equipment and manufacturing facilities:- The Bidder firm must have an annual capa city to manufacture and/or supply at least 50 Roll/400 Kg of similar type of "Plain White Nylon Plastic Str apping Roll". Undertaking regarding this requirement shall be submitted by the bidder on their Letter He ad.

3. Financial Standing:

a) The average annual turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2022 should b e at least Rs.79,200/- as per the annual report (Audited Balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account of releva nt Financial year shall be submitted) of Financial Year 2019-2020, 2020-2021 & 2021-2022, duly authenti cated by a chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countries

Note: The Average Annual Turnover criteria are exempted for Start-ups and Micro and Small Enterprises. I n case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eli gibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

b) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three yea rs, ending on '31.03.2022'.

(i) The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on '31.03.2022' and also

(ii) Should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on '31.03.2022'.

4. Applicability in Special Cases

a) Applicability to 'Make in India': Bidders (manufacturer or principal of authorised representative) If the product is being manufactured in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer who holds intelle ctual property rights and where there is a technology collaboration agreement/ transfer of technology agr eement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local co ntent, and who while meeting all other criteria above, except for any or more of sub-criteria in Experienc e and Past Performance above, would also be considered to be qualified provided: i) their foreign manufa cturer who holds intellectual property rights, meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the B idder submits appropriate documentary proof for technology collaboration agreement/ transfer of technol ogy agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content. iii) the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorised representative) furnishes along with the bid a legally enforceable undertaking jointly executed by himself and such foreign Manufacturer for s atisfactory manufacture, Supply (and erection, commissioning if applicable) and performance of 'The Pro duct' offered including all warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract.

b) Authorized Representatives: Bids of bidders quoting as authorised representative of a principal manufacturer would also be considered to be qualified, provided: i) their principal manufacturer meets all th e criteria above without exemption, and ii) the principal manufacturer furnishes a legally enforceable ten der-specific authorisation in the prescribed form assuring full guarantee and warranty obligations as per t he general and special conditions of contract; and iii) the bidder himself should have been associated, as authorised representative of the same or other Principal Manufacturer for same set of services as in prese nt bid (supply, installation, satisfactorily commissioning, after sales service as the case may be) for same or similar 'Product' for past three years ending on '31.01.2022.

c) For Existing successful Past Suppliers: In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorised representative) who is a successful past supplier of 'The Product' in at least one of the recent past three procurements, who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qual ified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past. (This clause is not applicable for Security Items as notified by Government of India from time to time.)

d) Joint Ventures and Holding Companies: Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (repe at cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, and each part ner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently However, for the purpose of qualifying the Finan cial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed with only one of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate legal documents proving such owne rship.

e) Development/ insufficient market capacity or Exceptional One- Off Cases: These are those ite ms which are either being newly developed where vendors are yet to be developed or for new/ existing it ems where the capacity available in market is inadequate compared to our annual requirements. Excepti onal one-off cases are such items/ Plant & Machinery which are procured infrequently (say once in 3 year s or longer periods). In such cases PQC Should be Decided with the approval of CFA in individual cases.

f) Start-up Enterprises: Requirements of prior experience and turnover would be relaxed for Start-up e nterprises as recognised by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), subject to th eir meeting the quality and technical specifications. Such Start-ups maybe either MSE or otherwise.

5. The Bidder shall give following undertakings on their Letter Head regarding this requireme nt.

i) **Blacklisting**: The bidder firm should submit declaration that, We, M/s. <Name of the bidder fir m> declaration that the firm has not been blacklisted/ debarred by any government agency / Pu blic Sector Unit/ Reputed organization.

ii) Agree to withdraw all deviations: The bidder firm should submit declaration that, We, M/s. <Name of the bidder firm> agree to withdraw all the deviations, if any, unconditionally and acce pt all the terms and conditions of the tender document including the technical specifications".

Sample must be submitted within 15 days of issue of GeM contract date. Sample suitability will be conveyed to the firm within 15 days from th e date of receipt of pre-productions sample.

2) Delivery Schedule:- Bulk quantity shall be submitted as per below:

i. 30 Roll – 60 days from the date of receipt of GeM Contract.

- ii. 30 Roll 150 days from the date of receipt of GeM Contract.
- iii. 30 Roll 240 days from the date of receipt of GeM Contract.
- iv. 35 Roll 330 days from the date of receipt of GeM Contract.

Note: ISP reserves the right to change the delivery schedule in future as per requirement.

3) Quality Control Requirement:-

(i) The material supplied by the successful bidder will be accepted on all parameters as per specification provided in the Bid Document. The purchaser reserves the right to get the material supplied tested from in-house laboratory or any other laboratory of repute and in case the material is found not meeting the sp ecification, the purchaser shall be entitled to cancel the contract, and if so desired, purchase or otherwise the purchase of the stores at the risk and cost of the contractor.

(ii) After receipt of goods, the goods will be inspected/tested at ISP. If any defect/variation is noticed then the same will be replaced free of cost by the supplier/seller up to India Security Press, Nashik Road, failin g which equivalent amount of defective material will be deducted in the subsequent bills or from any am ount due to them.

D. Special Conditions of Contract (SCC)

1) Transportation of Goods: The transportation of goods to be procured will be done by the supplier o n FOR ISP Basis. The total cost of the transportation should be indicated in the price bid of the item to be procured.

2) Insurance: Since Indigenous bidder has to deliver the material on FOR ISP Nashik basis therefore the cost of the insurance will also the part of the cost of the material borne by the supplier. A specific insuran ce cover for each consignment/supply is to be given by firm, as applicable.

3) Distribution of Dispatch Documents for Clearance/Receipt of Goods: The supplier shall send al I the relevant dispatch documents well in time to ISP Nashik to enable ISP Nashik to clear or receive (as t he case may be) the goods in terms of the contract.

4) Taxes and Duties: Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, fees, levies etc. incurre d until delivery of the contracted goods to SPMCIL. If the tenderer fails to include taxes and duties as per law of the land in the tender, no claim thereof will be considered by purchaser at a later stage.

5) Terms and Mode of Payment: 100% payment will be released within ten (10) days of issue of consi gnee receipt-cum-acceptance certificate (CRAC) and on-line submission of bills. The payment will be don e through online mode only. Therefore, the suppliers have to produce all the Bank details such as Name o f Bank, Account No., IFSC Code No., MICR No. along with the Tender document.
