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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 2. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
5. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
6. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 7. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. QUALIFICATION/ ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

(a) Experience and past performance:

The Bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative hereinafter simply as 'The Bidder') shall be a manufacturer that has regularly for at least three years manufactured, supplied, erected, commissioned Paper Folding Machine with same or higher specifications of at least one number in last five years ending on 31.03.2023. At least one number of the product offered for supply should be in successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.

Note: i) Copies of PO's and completion/experience certificates issued by customers to be provided in support of above.

ii) *Start-ups and Micro and small Enterprises are exempted from Experience and Past Performance criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.*

(b) Capability, equipment and manufacturing facilities:

(i) The Bidder firm must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least 01 No "Paper Folding Machine. The self attested details shall be submitted along with bid.

Note: i) At the discretion of the purchaser, the Capacity / Capability Assessment / Verification of bidder / manufacturer firm(s) might be undertaken by Tender Evaluation Committee or through a third party Technical Consultancy / Inspection agencies to ensure that the firm is/are identified and capable to supply the item/material/product as required.

(c) Financial standing:

(i) **Average Annual Turnover:** Average Annual financial Turnover of the Bidder during last three financial years i.e. 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 should be at least Rs.22,42,000/- as per annual report audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant in India.

Note: *The 'Average Annual Turnover criteria' is exempted for Startups and Micro and Small Enterprises.*

(ii) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years i.e. 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.

(iii) The net worth of the Bidder:

- a) It should not be negative on '31st March 2023'.
- b) It should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on '31st March 2023'.

(d) The criteria for *Capability, Equipment and Manufacturing facilities* as well as *financial loss and net worth under the financial standing eligibility criteria (above)* shall be **applicable to all the bidder firms including **MSEs & Startups Firms**.**

(e) For Existing successful Past Suppliers: In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) who is a successful past supplier of 'The Product' in at least one of the recent past three procurements, who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past. (This clause is not applicable for Security Items as notified by Government of India from time to time.)

2. **Undertaking(s):**

- (i) The firm should give undertaking that, **“the (Name of the bidder firm) has not blacklisted/debarred by any Government agency/ Public Sector Unit/ Reputed Organization”**.
- (ii) The firm should give undertaking that, **“We (Name of the bidder firm) agree to withdraw all the deviations, if any, unconditionally and accept all the terms and conditions of the tender document including the technical specifications”**.
- (iii) The information given in the documents are correct and the Bidder is aware that in case any information provided is found to be false at a later stage, ISP reserves the right to reject/disqualify the bidder at any stage of the tendering process without assigning any reason.

3. **Other Eligibility requirements for the Bidders:**

- 3.1 The bidder shall submit Local Content details as per clause No. 9; Verification of Local content, of Public procurement (Preference to make in India) order 2017 No. P-45021/2/2017-PP(BE-II).
- 3.2 The bidder shall provide names of Organization(s)/ Firm(s) with Addresses and Telephone numbers, Fax numbers, E-mail addresses to which manufacturer/ bidder firm has supplied similar type of **‘similar kind of paper folding machine’** in past.
- 3.3 The bidder has to submit **Power of Attorney/ Authorization** indicating that authorized signatory is competent and legally authorized to submit the tender and / or enter into legally binding contract.
- 3.4 **Manufacturer’s Authorization Letter:**
 - a) Wherever Authorized Bidder is submitting the bid, Authorization Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.
 - b) The bidder shall submit the manufacturer’s authorization letter to this effect as per the standard form provided in buyer uploaded ATC Uploaded document as per as per **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**.
 - c) One manufacturer can participate through one authorized agent or one agent can participate on behalf of one Principal Manufacturer only.
- 3.5 All experience, past performance and capacity/ capability related/ data should be certified by the authorized signatory of the bidder firm. The bidder should submit documentary evidence regarding the past supply. The credentials regarding experience and past performance to the extent required as per eligibility criteria submitted by bidder should be verified from the parties for whom work has been done, hence copies of orders and corresponding experience certificate are to be submitted along with offer.
- 3.6 The application should be submitted in English Language. The authenticated copies of the documents in support of the applicant’s claims must be submitted in **English language**.
- 3.7 **All financial standing data (Balance sheet and Profit & Loss Statements etc.) should be certified by certified accountants’ e.g. Chartered Accountants (CA).**
- 3.8 Decision on Finalization of tender will be taken based on the documents submitted along with the tender. All documents must be submitted as per tender requirement failing which offers will be liable for rejection and no further correspondence will be made/ entertained for clarification after opening of the tender.
- 3.9 All the pages submitted are to be required & sealed by Authorized Signatory failing which tender shall be treated as unresponsive.
- 3.10 Bidder firm shall submit the copy of PAN & GST Registration Certificate.

4. General Condition Of Contract (GCC):

4.1 Packing and Marking: As per Technical Specifications of the tender document.

4.2 Transportation of Goods: The transportation of goods to be procured will be done by the supplier on FOR ISP Basis. The total cost of the transportation should be indicated in the price bid of the item to be procured.

4.3 Inspection and Quality Control In addition to clause No. 9 of GCC the following shall also be applicable:-

a) Pre-dispatch Inspection:

- i) The Supplier shall communicate to the Purchaser prior to the readiness of the new machine to arrange visit of representatives for pre-dispatch inspection. The inspection shall be carried out by authorized representatives of SPMCIL/ISP. Travelling, lodging, boarding expenses will be borne by ISP. Consumables and other materials required for the trial will be arranged by the supplier.
- ii) The inspection procedure and the arrangement will be according to the Contract agreed mutually between the Supplier and the Purchaser.

b) FAT(Final Acceptance Test) and FAC(Final Acceptance Certificate):-

- i) Upon completion or erection and commissioning work at the Purchaser's premises, Purchaser will conduct testing of the system in presence of Supplier's representatives. The FAT will be carried out for a period of 12 (twelve) full working days, consisting of eight productive hours per day, conforming to the machine configuration i.e. machine, speed, output etc. as per the tender specifications.
- ii) If any of the parameters is not achieved due to any reason not attributed to the Purchaser, the acceptance test will be conducted ab-initio. After successful FAT, Final Acceptance Certificate will be issued.

c) Training:

At Purchaser's Site:

The Supplier shall provide training to authorized persons of ISP in the technique and skills required to operate and to repair the new machine, for six days @ eight hours working per day, for Supervisory Staff and Industrial Workmen for Technical, Electrical, Mechanical and Instrumentation, as required by ISP.

4.4 Insurance: A specific insurance cover for each consignment / supply is to be given by the firm, as applicable.

4.5 a) Warranty Clause: The Warranty period of the machine starts from the date of issue of the Final Acceptance Certificate. The Warranty period is valid for a period of 12(twelve) months.

b)Performance Guarantee:

The Supplier should give performance Guarantee Bond for its best workmanship, testing, material and satisfactory performance for a period of one year.

c)Maintenance Warranty:

- i. The supplier will be able to modify/ replace free-of-cost may fail/ go defective/ requires modifications during warranty period.
- ii. In case a particular part fails during maintenance warranty period of one year, the s

supplier shall be liable to extend warranty of the fresh supply of the part for a further one year from the date of replacement.

4.6 Taxes and Duties: If the tenderer fails to include taxes and duties as per law of the land in the tender, no claim thereof will be considered by purchaser at a later stage.

4.7 Terms and Mode of Payment: The payment shall be made in the following manner-
a) 100% payment after final acceptance of the machine by the user after installation and submission of required document.

5. Required Delivery Schedule: The successful firm shall supply and complete the installation, testing and commissioning work within 120 days from the date of issue of GeM Contract.

6. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, Orders (Public Procurement 1,2 and 3) F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/ 24th July 2020 (or any further amendments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from specified countries shall be applicable to this tender. Bidders are required submit the appropriate undertaking in this regard. Salient features of this are:

(i) Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (excluding countries as listed in the website of Ministry of External Affairs, to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects) will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Department for promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). The bidders shall enclose following certificate in this regard.

(ii) In tenders for Turnkey contracts including works contracts, the successful bidder shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is similarly registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). In such cases the bidders shall enclose following certificate:

"We have read the clause regarding restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India and on sub-contracting to contractors from such countries; and solemnly certify that we are not from such a country or, if from such a country, we are registered with Competent Authority (copy enclosed) and we will not subcontract any work to a contractor from such countries unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority. We hereby certify that we fulfill all requirements in this regard and are eligible to be considered."

(iii) "Bidder" including the terms 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts means any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.

(iv) "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means:-

- a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.

(v) The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:

a) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more judicial person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercise control through other means.

b) Explanation:

(1) "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five per cent of shares or capital or profits of the company.

(2) In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of Capital or profits of the partnership.

(3) In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of individuals;

(4) Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official.

(5) In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

(vi) An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.
