In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. The Bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify in the Techno Commercial Bi d:-

i) Experience and Past Performance:- The bidder should have manufactured / supplied of at leas t 4 nos of Laser Scan Mirror in any one of the last five years ending on 31.03.2023.

Note: the Experience and Past Experience Criteria is exempted for startups and Micro and Small Enterprises.

ii) Capability:- The bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture / supply at least at leas t 4 nos of Laser Scan Mirror.

A) For Existing successful Past Suppliers: In case the bidder who is a successful past supplier of ' The Product' in at least one of the recent past three procurements, who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credential s, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past. (This clause is not applicable for Security Items as notified by Government of India from time to time.)

B) Joint Ventures and Holding Companies: Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (r epeat cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, an d each partner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently However, for the purpose of qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed with only one of t he fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate leg al documents proving such ownership.

(iii) **PAN:** The Bidder should be registered with the Income tax. Relevant proof in support shall be s ubmitted.

(iv) Goods & Service Tax Registration (GST): The Bidder should be registered with Goods & Servi ce Tax (GST). Relevant proof of registration Certificate shall be submitted.

(v) Undertaking:-

a) "We M/s_____ have not been blacklisted by Government of India in the past."

b) "We M/s_____ agree to withdraw all the deviations, if any, unconditionally and accept all the Terms and conditions of the document including the technical specifications."

3. Delivery Schedule: - Within 30 days from the date of issue of Contract.

4. Warranty: - Warranty for the period of one year.

5. Quantum of LD:- If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services wi thin the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to de duct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure condition s aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of dela yed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantit y without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

6. Payment Terms: - Payment will be released within ten (10) days of issue of Consignee Receiptcum Acceptance Certificate (CRAC) and submission of bills. 7. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, Orders (Public Procurement 1,2 and 3) F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/ 24th July 2020 (or an y further amendments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from specified countries shall be applicable to this tender. Bidders are required submit the appropriate underta king in this regard. Salient features of this are:

(i) Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (excluding countries as listed i n the website of Ministry of External Affairs, to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects) will be eligible t o bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Department for promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). The bidders shall enclose foll owing certificate in this regard.

"We have read the clause regarding restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India; and solemnly certify that we are not from such a country or, if fro m such a country, we are registered with the Competent Authority (copy enclosed). We hereby cer tify that we fulfill all requirements in this regard and are eligible to be considered."

(ii) In tenders for Turnkey contracts including works contracts, the successful bidder shall not be all owed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is similarly registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). In such cases the bidders shall e nclose following certificate:

"We have read the clause regarding restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India and on sub-contracting to contractors from such countries,; and so lemnly certify that we are not from such a country or, if from such a country, we are registered wi th Competent Authority (copy enclosed) and we will not subcontract any work to a contractor from such countries unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority. We hereby certi fy that we fulfill all requirements in this regards and are eligible to be considered."

(iii) "Bidder" including the terms 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) mea ns any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (th at is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not f alling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or offi ce controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.

(iv) "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order me ans:- a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or

b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or

c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in suc h a country; or

d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or

- e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or

g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.

(v) The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:

a) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more judicial person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercise control through other means. b) Explanation:

(1) "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five p er cent of shares or capital or profits of the company.

(2) In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more t han fifteen percent of Capital or profits of the partnership.

(3) In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natu ral person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of suc h association or body of individuals;

(4) Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the r elevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official.

(5) In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the auth or of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and a ny other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of cont rol or ownership.

(vi) An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.

Disclaimer/अस्वीकरण

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
