1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

- ii. The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last t hree years, ending on 31.03.2023
- iii. The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on 31.03.2023 and should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2023.

A) Authorized Representatives: Bids of bidders quoting as authorised representative of a princ ipal manufacturer would also be considered to be qualified, provided: i) their principal manufactur er meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the principal manufacturer furnishes a le gally enforceable tender-specific authorisation in the prescribed form assuring full guarantee and warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract; and iii) the bidder hims elf should have been associated, as authorised representative of the same or other Principal Manu facturer for same set of services as in present bid (supply, installation, satisfactorily commissionin g, after sales service as the case may be) for same or similar 'Product' for past three years ending on '31.03.2023'.

C) Joint Ventures and Holding Companies: Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures canno t (repeat cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, and each partner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently However, for the purpose of qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed with only one of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate leg al documents proving such ownership.

2. **Quantum of LD**:- If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditi ons aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of d elayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

(3) In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natu ral person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of suc h association or body of individuals;

(4) Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the r elevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official.

(5) In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the auth or of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and

any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of con trol or ownership.
