I. Experience & Past performance: - The Bidder should have experience of having successfully supplied the manpower services of 1373 man-days in any one of the last five years ending on 31st March 2023.

Note 1: For MSEs and Start-ups (registered for the tendered item) Experience & Past Performance criteria shall be exempted.

II. Capability: - The bidder must have capability to provide the relevant services. **“We M/s. <Name of the firm> have the Capability to provide the relevant services” as mentioned in the tender.**

III. Financial standing: -

a) The average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March 2023, should be at least Rs. 16,86,540/- as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/ Cost Accountant in India.

b) i) The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on 31.3.2023 and also (ii) should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2023.

Note 1: To ascertain these criteria net worth of initial and last financial year should be compared.

Note 2: For MSEs and Start-ups (registered for the tendered item) all financial criteria shall be exempted.

V. Undertaking:-

VI. Terms and Conditions of Contract

1) The manpower supplier firm must fulfill all the conditions required under Contract Labour Act, must have a valid PF code & ESIC code in its name and copy of the same must be submitted along with the tender.

2) Hours of work: The working hours shall be 09.00 AM to 06.00 PM with 1 hour lunch break. However the timing may be changed at the discretion of the management from time to time.

3) The required strength of manpower shall be 11 (Eleven) Nos. at present. It may be increased/decreased based on the requirement. Any increase/decrease thereby in the actual supplied manpower shall increase/reduce the payment to be made proportionately as per contracted rates.

4) The eligibility criterion for Data Entry Operators is Graduate in any discipline with working knowledge of MS- Office with age between 20 to 40 years only. They should have one year experience in office procedure as Data Entry Operator/equivalent in any reputed firm and hold certificate with typing speed of English 40 wpm/Hindi or Marathi 30 wpm. The deployed data entry operator’s resume must be evaluated by the Firm to get satisfied about their credentials. 5) Agency should provide Police Verification/Antecedent & Character Certificate of the manpower. The clearance of the local police with regards the antecedents of the persons deployed by it will be obtained by the agency before deployment of the personnel.

6) The manpower supplier firm shall in no case pay its employees less than the minimum mandatory rates per month in accordance with the Minimum Wages fixed by Central /State Govt whichever is higher and a r

record of that should be kept in a register, which may be made available for examination as and when demanded.

7) The names of the workers to be supplied by the agency shall be made known to the authorities with their identity card / employment number, before commencing supply. The frequent changes in the manpower will not be allowed.

8) The rates quoted shall be for the entire period of the contract. Any amendment thereafter shall be the sole option of India Security Press, Nasik. The said rate shall be quoted keeping in the mind that the statutory compliance of all labor laws / regulations must be in compliance by the contractor/agency.

9) Payment, the payment (s) shall be made to the contractor are subject to deduction of tax (s) Cess leviable by any Government as per rules from time to time and will be made after the completion of every month on completion of the assigned work and after certification by user department. The bill must be submitted in duplicate. Further, the agency shall furnish a copy deposition of monthly EPF/ESIC challans /returns etc . with next bill, failing which amount as deemed fit by India Security Press, Nasik shall be withheld in the next subsequent bill.

10) The manpower supplier firm should make suitable arrangement for supervision of the manpower supplied and other related works.

11) The agency shall ensure that their staff supplied for service in India Security Press, Nasik premises shall be available during their duty hours as per the roster and they shall not leave their place of duty without authorization.

12) The agency staff shall be responsible to provide immediate replacement for personnel who are not available on duty at the place of posting for any emergency and pressing reasons.

13) India Security Press, Nasik authorities shall have the right to seek replacement of any staff of the agency by any other suitable person in case the staff is not discharging its services properly. The decision by ISP, Nasik shall be final and the agency shall comply with the same at the earliest.

14) The agency staff shall carry out such other legitimate duties as are entrusted to them from time to time.

15) ISP, Nasik is not responsible for any dispute of manpower supplied, and the manpower so provided shall not be in any way is the employees of ISP, Nasik.

16)The manpower supplier firm will be responsible for making the payment digitally bank transfer NEFT/RTGS to the supplied manpower by 07th day after the last day of the wage period in respect of which the wages are payable. Contractor also has to issue wage slips to the labours before wages disbursement. Contractor need to maintain separate records for our establishment and need to file separate challan and returns in respect of ESI and EPF to the contract labour engaged with our organization and subsequently raise the bill for reimbursement which will be verified on the basis of actual amount disbursed and attendance etc. And will pay within 7 days after payment of wages & statutory payment. Manpower supplier liable for penalty as decided by ISP, Nasik management for not making timely payment to its manpower as per above schedule.

17) The contract will be for one year in the first instance. However, the contract can be extended on the same terms and conditions subject to satisfactory work of the contractor by another 1 years or till the execution of new contract whichever is earlier.

18) The manpower supplier firm shall have to engage the required number of manpower and in case required number is not available on any day without proper and acceptable reason ISP, Nasik can impose penalty on manpower supplier firm as it thinks fit.

19)If the contractor repeatedly violates the terms and conditions of the contract or fails to supply required number of data entry operators, despite ISP, Nasik, having served him proper notices, the contract shall be liable to be terminated and security deposited shall be forfeited. 20) In case of disputes for non-payment of wages to the supplied manpower or any other disputes, the payment due to the manpower supplier firm can be withheld till settlement of the disputes by the board or on the orders of the court of law.

21)The contractor shall abide by all the law of land including Labour Laws (PF, ESI, Income Tax, Service Tax or any other extra taxes levied by the Government).

22)The contract can be terminated by the ISP, Nasik by giving a month notice. The contractor/agency can terminate the contract by giving three months' notice.

23) In case the contractor/ Agency leaves the job before completion of the period of contract, ISP, Nasik shall be entitled to forfeit the security money deposited by the contractor/agency for the execution of this contract. The same shall be over and above the liquidated damages suffered on such account by ISP, Nasik

24) Price Escalation clause: Price escalation may be applicable at the sole discretion of ISP management in case of any change in statutory payment of Minimum Wages applicable by amendments issued from time to time by State Govt. in this regard.

25) The contractor shall have to fulfill all the statutory requirements like PF/ESI as per the provisions of law i.e. Contract Labour R & A Act 1970 & Contract Labour R&A Rules 1971., Minimum wages Act 1948 applicable in Nasik region excluding taxes, Payment of Wages Act 1936, Maharashtra Labour Welfare Contribution (MLWC) & other related labour Legislations etc., and shall indemnify the Company from any claims in future or due to any breach of the statutory requirements. The company, as a principle employer, shall enforce the provisions of these Acts.

26) It is the responsibility of the contractor to obtain license under the Contract Labour Act from the Concerned Labour Commissioner if engaging more than 18 workmen.

VII. Scope of Work

The Data Entry operators shall be responsible for following activities, in conformity with the relevant procedures, during the period of contract.

Nature of Duties:

Daily entry, accounts, posting of entries in SAP, Handling & Maintenance of Files / Records /Registers, Assistance to Superiors in day-to-day office work.

Typing of letters / Preparation of various letters, reports in MS Word / Excel or preparation of Presentation for various meetings and filing of papers in respective files and maintain various files and assisting Office Staff in their regular day to day work of required section under directives of supervisors/Executives of the concerned section.

All Typing/Drafting of communication/files of concerned departments pertaining to record keeping and sorting of files of concerned department.

Unit may include any other work from time to time as per requirements of management. They shall work under the overall supervision of the Head of the Section.

Responsibilities:

Data Entry, entering data, recording data, maintaining related records, typing official letters, handling the E-office system, preparing notes, sanctions, and other official documents as directed by competent authority. These responsibilities should be in a more structured and clear manner.

Note 1: - The Service Provider liable to Pay Minimum wages for Skilled Data Entry Operator as per latest Central Labour Commissioner (CLC) Notification issued by time to time and allied benefits such as PF, ESIC, Bonus, etc .

Note 2: - if the bidder quoted total value of contract below estimated cost i.e. Rs. 42,16,350/- as mentioned in bid document, their offer will be rejected.

 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
