Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. For Existing successful Past Suppliers: In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) who is a successful past **supplier** of 'The Product' in at least one of the recent past three procurements (within SPMCIL/BRBNMPL/BNPMIPL), who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supply

d. Make in India Status; it is requested to provide a certificate from statutory auditor or cost auditor of your company.

6. The bidder has to submit **Power of Attorney/ Authorization** indicating that authorized signatory is competent and legally authorized to submit the tender and / or enter into legally binding contract. All experience, past performance and capacity/ capability related/ data should be certified by the authorized signatory of the bidder firm

7. Manufacturer's Authorization Letter:

i. Wherever Authorized Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorization Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.

19. Technical and Service Agreement: A technical and service agreement would be entered between the Purchaser and the Supplier which shall remain valid for a period of at least 10 years. The supplier would also keep India Security Press, Nashik updated on latest developments in technologies from time to time. They would also respond to queries raised by India Security Press, Nashik through e-mail, FAX, phone etc.

20. Machine Guarantee: Each machine must be guaranteed for 12 months after Final Acceptance Test, as per the Contractual Obligations.

21. Performance Guarantee: The supplier shall guarantee each machine for its best material and satisfactory performance for a period of 12 months from the date of acceptance, as per Contractual Obligations.

22. Maintenance Guarantee: The supplier will be liable to modify / replace the parts free of cost that may fail / go defective / requires modification at their own expenses up to the expiry of the guarantee period i.e. for a period of 12 months from the date of issue of Final Acceptance Certificate.

23. Packing and Marking: As per Technical Specifications of the tender document.
