If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. 4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match

L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. 5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

6. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery

time shall be (Increased quantity \div Original quantity) \times Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

The Bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify in the Techno Commercial Bid:-

I) For MSE/Start-up firm: Capability - Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities: The bidder firm shoul d have capability to Manufacture, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of the tendered item.

(This clause is not applicable for Security Items as notified by Government of India from time to time.)

IV) PAN: The Bidder should be registered with the Income tax. Relevant proof in support shall be submitte d.

V) Goods & Service Tax Registration (GST): The Bidder should be registered with Goods & Service Ta x (GST). Relevant proof of registration Certificate shall be submitted.

VI) Undertaking:-

- a. The bidder has to provide the undertaking that "We M/s. <Name of the firm> have not been blackli sted by Government of India/Any State Government/PSU/Any reputed Organization in the past ".
- b. The bidder has to provide the undertaking that "We M/s. <Name of the firm> agree to withdraw all the deviations, if any, unconditionally and accept all the Terms and conditions of the tender d ocument including the technical specifications."

VII) Delivery Schedule:- Within 24 weeks (168 days) from the date of issuance of GeM Contract.

VIII) Warranty Clause:- Warranty shall be applicable for one year form date of acceptance of material at ISP.

IX) Quantum of LD:- If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within t he original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% o f the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated d amages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of a ny sort whatsoever.

X) Terms and Mode of Payment: 100% payment will be released within 30 days after successful supply and installation of the item and its acceptance by ISP.

XI) Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, Orders (Publi

c Procurement 1,2 and 3) F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/ 24th July 2020 (or any further ame ndments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from specified countries shall be applicable t o this tender. Bidders are required submit the appropriate undertaking in this regard. Salient features of this are:

d) "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means:- a) A n entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or

i) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or

ii) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a coun try; or

iii) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or

iv) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or

v) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or

vi) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of th e above.

e) The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:

i) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more judicial person, has a controlling ownership inter est or who exercise control through other means.

ii) Explanation:

(1) "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five pe r cent of shares or capital or profits of the company.

(2) In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting al one or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of Capital or profits of the partnership.

(3) In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natur al person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownershi

p of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of suc h association or body of individuals;

(4) Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the rel evant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official.

(5) In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the auth or of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

(6) An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings wit h third person.

XII) "Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS): By participating in this tender, the suppli ers/Vendors/ Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to V igilance."

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
