- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. - 3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 5. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 6. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company

- 7. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 8. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 9. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

Special terms and conditions-Version:2 effective from 29-01-2025 for category Customised Ambulance with Equipment

1. Special Terms and Conditions for Customized Ambulance with Equipment

This category is created to cater to the requirement of buyer where the buyer wants to procure Ambulance with medical devices and/or minor fabrications. This category is bid only category and Direct Purchase is not enabled.

- 1. The buyer shall define the equipment required in the Ambulance with complete technical specifications along with quantity. The buyer may refer AIS 125 (Part2) for list of equipment.
- 2. In case fabrication is required by the buyer inside the body of the Ambulance, details and drawings/pictures shall be provided by the buyer in the bid.
- 3. The buyer should check compliance of the vehicle to CMVR rules and compliance to AIS 125 (Part1)

after fabrication and installation of medical devices.

Note for Sellers:

- For listing a catalog on GeM, the seller should specify the price for the vehicle. As the category is bid-only, the seller can submit their offer price while participating in the bid, based on the scope of work provided by the buyer.
- The seller should upload images that include the vehicle's front view, side view, and rear view with the door open.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions/क्रेता द्वारा जोड़ी गई बिड की विशेष शर्तें

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

The technical specification provided in the Buyer added ATC document will supersede the above-mentioned specification. And the bidder shall strictly participate as per the technical specifications enclosed in the buyer added ATC document of the bid.

IV. Qualification/ Eligibility Criteria:

(1) Experience and past performance: The Bidder should have fabricated and supplied at least one number of "Advance Life Support (ALS) Ambulance (Type-D)" with the same or higher specifications in the last five years ending on 31st March 2024. At least one number of the product offered for supply should be in successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.

Note:

- i) Copies of PO's and completion/experience certificates issued by customers to be provided in sup port of above.
- ii) Start-ups and Micro and small Enterprises are exempted from Experience and Past Performance criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation..

Note: For MSEs and Start-ups (registered for the tendered item) Experience and Past Performanc e criteria shall be exempted.

(2) Capability, equipment and manufacturing facilities: The Bidder firm must have an annual capacity to fabricate and supply at least (01) Number of "Advance Life Support (ALS) Ambulance (Type-D)". The self-attested details shall be submitted along with bid.

Note: At the discretion of the purchaser, the Capacity / Capability Assessment / Verification of bidd er / manufacturer firm(s) might be undertaken by a Committee or through a third party Technical Consultancy / Inspection agencies to ensure that the firm is/are identified and capable to supply the machine/item/material/product as required.

(3) Financial standing:

- a) The Average Annual Financial Turnover of the Bidder during the last three financial year s ending on 31.03.2024 should be at least **Rs. 14,60,000/-** as per the annual report (audited bala nce sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period. Duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countries.
- b) i) The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on 31.03.2024 and ii) also should n ot have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2024.

Note 1: To ascertain this criterion net worth of initial and last financial year should be compared.

Note 2: For MSEs and Start-ups (registered for tendered item) all financial criteria shall be exempt ed. However, its capacity and capability may be verified (if necessary) by the respective unit as per the standard format.

V. <u>Important Instructions to bidders before participation:</u> Bidder should quote prices of Vehicle s inclusive of RTO registration charges, Insurance of Vehicle for period of one year, GST and all other cost components such as Other Taxes, Packing & Forwarding details, Freight & transportation Insurance charges upto destination etc. on FOR India Security Press, Nashik Road (Maharashtra), basis only. After award of contract, the contract price will be final and no additional charges will be considered by ISP-Nashik at later stage.

Further, at the time of delivery, firm should ensure to submit all documents like Invo ices, Warranty Certificates, RTO Registration documents, RC books, Insurance of vehicles, Tec hnical Literature/Brochure of Vehicles without fail. Otherwise, payment will not be made till the completion of delivery in all respects.

VI. Bidder must submit its offered specifications along with the bid for Ambulance without whi ch offer of the firm will be rejected. Further, firm should submit the acceptance of the detaile d specifications as per Buyer uploaded ATC document along with the sealed & signed copy of same along with bid document. Before submitting the bid, bidder should ensure that offered s pecifications should be as per the Buyer uploaded ATC document (within the range specified).

VII. Undertaking:-

- a) The bidder has to provide the undertaking that "We M/s. have not been black-listed/ debarred f or dealing with any Govt. Organization / Public Sector Undertaking (PSU) / Reputed Organization in the past".
- b) The bidder has to provide the undertaking that "We M/s. agree to withdraw all the deviations, if any, unconditionally and accept all the Terms and conditions of the document including the technical specifications."
- VIII. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, Orde rs (Public Procurement 1,2,3 and 4) F. No. 7/10/2021-PPD(1) dated 23.02.2023 (or any f urther amendments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from specified countries sh all be applicable to this tender. Bidders are required submit the appropriate undertaking in this regard. Salient features of this are:
- I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in any pro curement whether of goods, services (including consultancy services and non-consultancy service s) or work (including turnkey projects) only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authorit y. Further, any bidder (including bidder from India) having specified Transfer of Technology (ToT) arrangement with an entity from a country which shares a land border with India, shall also requir e to be registered with the same competent authority.
- II. "Bidders" (including the term 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) m eans any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that i s an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.
- III. "Bidder (or entity) from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means:-
 - (a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - (b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such country; or
 - (c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or register ed in such a country; or
 - (d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
 - (e) An Indian (or other)agent or such an entity; or
 - (f) A natural person who is citizen of such a country; or
 - (g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture fall under any of the above.
 - IV. The beneficial owner for the purpose of (iii) above will be as under:

1. In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether action alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through means.

Explanation-

- a. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twent y-five per cent. Of shares or capital or profits of the company;
- b. "Control" shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the man agement or policy decisions including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders agreements or voting agreements;
- 2. In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlem ent to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership;
- 3. In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or cap ital or profits of such association or body of individuals;
- 4. Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official;
- 5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through chain of control or ownership.
- V. An agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in de alings with third person.
- VI. [To be inserted in tenders for Work contracts, including Turnkey contracts] The successf ul bidder shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Au thority.
- VII. The registration shall be valid at the time of submission of bid and at the time of accept ance of bid.
- VIII. If the bidder was validly registered at the time of acceptance/placement of order, registration shall be a relevant consideration during contract execution.

Model Certificate for Tenders:

"I have read the clause regarding restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which share a land border with India; I certify that this bidder is not from such a country or, if from such a country, has been registered with the Competent Authority. I hereby certify that the bidder fulfils all requirements in this regard and is eligible to be considered. [Where applicable, evidence of valid registration by the Competent Authority shall be attached.]"

VIII. Terms and Mode of Payment: Payment will be released within thirty (30) days of issue of Consignee Receipt-cum Acceptance Certificate (CRAC) and submission of bills. Further, at the ti

me of delivery, firm should ensure to submit all documents like Invoices, Warranty Cert ificates, RTO Registration documents, RC books, Insurance of vehicles, Technical Litera ture/Brochure of Vehicles without fail. Otherwise, payment will not be made till the completion of delivery in all respects.

- **X. Quantum of LD**:- If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditi ons aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of d elayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.
- **XI. Manufacturer's Authorisation Letter:** In case the bidder firm/ bidder offers to supply "Adv ance Life Support (ALS) Ambulance (Type-D)", which is manufactured by some other firm, the bid der has to be duly authorized by the manufacturer of the stated material to quote for and supply the same to India Security Press, a unit of SPMCIL. The bidder shall submit the manufacturer's authorization letter to this effect as per the standard form provided in "buyer uploaded ATC Uploaded document".
- **IX. Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS):** By participating in this tender, the suppliers/V endors/ Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance."
