**I) For MSE/Start-up firm: Capability -Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities:** The bidder firm should have capability to supply the services as per tender document. The bidder firm has to provide undertaking that,

1. The vehicle provided by the bidder shall be for day-to-day company (India Security Press, Nashik) work without fuel and without driver basis. The vehicle provided by bidder shall be in good running condition, good interior & exterior in all respect and not old more than Year 2022) BS-VI model (Not run more than 30000K.M). Vehicle follows latest norms and taxi permit.
2. Vehicle will be hired on without driver and without fuel basis. Vehicle to be available 24X7 basis hrs for the period of one year with valid permit to use within and outside the area i.e. Maharashtra & Other States (if required ) for period of one year.

3. The driver shall be provided by India Security Press, Nashik.
4. Period of Contract: -The services should be provided for one year and agreement would be valid from the date of issue of the work order. ISP shall have option to extend the contract by 25% i.e. 3 month at the same rate, Terms and condition.
5. Vehicle: The Goods Truck should have capability to be used for above mentioned scope of work and the pickup vehicle shall be utility vehicle Double cabin Pick up vehicle Mahindra Camper or equivalent of any other make.
6. Duty Timings: The vehicle required for 24 Hours at India Security Press, Nashik.
7. The fuel (High Speed Diesel) shall be provided by India Security Press, Nashik. The running maintenance / Breakdown repairs, Oiling and greasing shall be responsibility of contractor of the vehicle.
8. Registration of vehicle, fitness, Compressive Insurance, Pollution certificate, RTO Document and other required document will be maintained by the bidder.
9. Any compensation on account of accident or damage to the vehicle or for death of any third party / ISP employee or injury or loss should be covered under terms and condition of insurance and the same should be ensured by the contractor, no liability towards ISP.
10. Vehicle should be fitted with fastag and fastag statement should be submitted along with monthly bill for payment. Minimum fast tag balance Rs.1000/- at all time to be maintained.
11. Rates: The rate should be quoted with travel up to 2000 KM on per month basis. If the vehicle runs extra KM in a month after maximum fixed kilometer, then Extra KM rates will be calculated as per the formula mentioned in the SLA.
12. If hired vehicle is sent for servicing or maintenance, other similar vehicle should be provided free of cost by the bidder and no additional payment made for the same.

#### Clarification of Bids/Shortfall Documents:

During the evaluation and comparison of bids, the purchaser may, at his discretion, ask the bidder for clarifications on the bid.
