Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity \div Original quantity) \times Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

- (IV) Quantum of LD:-If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buy er will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered un der Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever
- **(V) Delivery Schedule: -** Supply one hybrid pallet truck for Checking the feasibility at central stamp depot shopfloor within 21 days from the date of issue of GeM Contract.
- **a)** Remaining 03 (Three) nos of pallet truck will be supplied within 60 days from the date of is sue of GeM Contract after confirmation by user section.
- **b)** All delivery is to be made at Central Stamp Depot, India Security Press, Nashik Road premis
- **c)** The Warranty / Guarantee, Maintenance and comprehensive services and repair including all body parts, spare parts and battery along with charger (All to be covered under Warranty / Guarantee, Maintenance and service and repair) should be one year from the date of supply a t free of cost at Central Stamp Depot, India Security Press, Nashik Road premises,
- **d)** All supplies should be address to "Manager, Central Stamp Depot (Shopfloor) India Security Press Nashik Road 422101".
- **(VI) Payment Terms: -** Payment will be released within one month from the date of confirm ation from user section based on the submission of the documents in original by supplier.
- **(VII) Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS):** By participating in this tender, the suppl iers'/Vendors/ Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, an y financial or n on-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract there after and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance."
- (VIII) Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, Orders (Public Procurement 1,2 and 3) F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/ 24th July 2 020 (or any further amendments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from speci fied countries shall be applicable to this tender. Bidders are required submit the appropriate undertaking in this regard. Salient features of this are:
- (i) Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (excluding countries as list ed in the website of Ministry of External Affairs, to which the Government of India has extende d lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects) will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Department for promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). - (iii) "Bidder" including the terms 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contex ts) mea ns any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint vent ure (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.
- (iv) "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Orde r means: a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls un der any of the above.
- (v) The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:
- a) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural per son(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more judicial person, has a c ontrolling ownership interest or who exercise control through other means.
- b) Explanation:
- (1) "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five per cent of shares or capital or profits of the company.
- (2) In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether ac ting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of Capital or profits of the partnership.
- (3) In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical pers on, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or p rofits of such association or body of individuals;
- (4) Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official.
- (5) In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

The request for clarification shall be sought only once on GeM portal, asking the bidder to respond by a specified date/period (i.e. Three days). If the bidder does not comply or respond by the date/period (i.e. within Three days), his tender will be liable to be rejected.

Depending on the outcome, such bids are to be ignored or considered further. No post-bid

clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained.

Note: While submitting the Clarification/Shortfall Document any technical difficulty occurs on GeM portal, then the bidder can submit the Clarification / Shortfall Document through e-mail (e-mail id: purchase.isp@spmcil.com).

The Procuring Entity reserves its right to, but without any obligation to do so, seek any sho rtfall information/ documents only in case of historical documents that pre-existed at the ti me of the Bid Opening, and which have not undergone change since then and does not gra nt any undue advantage to any bidder. As far as the submission of documents is concerned regarding qualification criteria, after submission of the bid, only related shortfall document s shall be asked for and considered.

For example, if the bidder has submitted a supply order without its completion/performanc e certificate, the certificate will be asked for and considered. However, no new supply orde r shall be asked for to qualify the bidder.

- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
