Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

- 1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.
- 2. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

The Bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify in the Techno Commercial Bid:-

I) Experience and Past Performance: - The Bidder should have Manufactured & Supplied at least 104 Nos. of Pneumatic cylinders as per attached technical specifications (for details refer technical specifications attached) in any one of the last five years ending on 31.03.2024.

Note: i) Copies of PO's and completion/experience certificates issued by customers to be provided in sup port of above.

- ii) Start-ups and Micro and small Enterprises are exempted from Experience and Past Performance criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.
- **II)** Capability-Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities: The bidder firm must have an annual capacity to Manufacture & Supply at least 104 Nos. of Pneumatic cylinders as per att ached technical specifications (for details refer technical specifications attached).

III) Financial Standing: -

a) The Average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2024 s

hould be at least Rs. 11,55,400.00/- as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account of FY 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Account ant/Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countries.

- i) The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on 31.03.2024 and also
- ii) should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2024.
- Note 1: To ascertain this criteria net worth of initial and last financial year should be compare d.

Note 2: For MSEs and Start-ups (registered for the tendered item) all financial criteria shall be exempted.

- **IV) For Existing successful Past Suppliers:** In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) who is a successful past supplier of 'The Product' in at least one of the recent past three p rocurements, who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past. (This clause is not applicable for Security Items as notified by Government of India from time to time.)
- **V) Joint Ventures and Holding Companies:** Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (repe at cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, and each part ner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently However, for the purpose of qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed with only on e of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate legal documents proving such ownership.
- **VI) PAN:** The Bidder should be registered with the Income tax. Relevant proof in support shall be submitt ed.
- **VII) Goods & Service Tax Registration (GST):** The Bidder should be registered with Goods & Service Tax (GST). Relevant proof of registration Certificate shall be submitted.

VIII) Undertaking:-

- a) We M/s _____firm has not been blacklisted by Government of India/PSU/Any reputed organization in the past."
- b) "We M/s____ agree to withdraw all the deviations, if any, unconditionally and accept all the Terms and conditions of the bid document including the technical specifications."

IX) Note:

- a) The Indian agent on behalf of the Principal/ OEM or principal/OEM itself can bid but both cannot bid sim ultaneously for the same item/ product in the same Bid. If an agent submits bid on behalf of the Principal/ OEM, the same agent shall not submit a bid on behalf of another Principal/ OEM in the same Bid for the same item.
- b) Interested firms are requested to submit the above required documents sealed and signed on all pages along with Bid.
- c) The Bid should be completed in all the respect including submission of all the required documents so th at further clarification may not be called for.
- d) "Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS): By participating in this tender, the suppliers/Vendors/ Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they n otice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance."

- X) Delivery Schedule: Within Sixty (60) Days from the date of issue of Contract.
- **XI) Manufacturer's authorization letter**: In case the bidder firm/ Bidder offers to supply of the Pneuma tic cylinders/accessories which is manufactured by some other firm, the Bidder has to be duly authorized by the manufacturer of the stated plant to quote for and supply and install the same to India Security Pres s, a unit of SPMCIL.
- **XII) Payment Terms: -** Payment will be released within thirty (30) days of issue of Consignee Receipt-cu m Acceptance Certificate (CRAC) and submission of bills.
- **XIII)** Clarification of Bids/Shortfall Documents: During the evaluation and comparison of bids, the pur chaser may, at his discretion, ask the bidder for clarifications on the bid. The request for clarification shall be sought only once on GeM portal, asking the bidder to respond by a specified date/period (i.e. Seven days). If the bidder does not comply or respond by the date/period (i.e. within Seven days), his tender will be liable to be rejected.

Depending on the outcome, such bids are to be ignored or considered further. No post-bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained.

The Procuring Entity reserves its right to, but without any obligation to do so, seek any shortfall information/ documents only in case of historical documents that pre-existed at the time of the Bid Openi ng, and which have not undergone change since then and does not grant any undue advantage to any bid der. As far as the submission of documents is concerned regarding qualification criteria, after submission of the bid, only related shortfall documents shall be asked for and considered.

For example, if the bidder has submitted a supply order without its completion/performance certificate, the certificate will be asked for and considered. However, no new supply order shall be asked for to qualify the bidder.

XIV) Note regarding MSE and MII purchase preference:

For MSE Purchase Preference:

Instant bid is non-splitable / non-dividable in nature. Therefore, in case L1 is non-MSE then MSE firm quoti ng price within L1+15% band will be awarded full tendered quantity subject to matching the L1 prices.

For MII Purchase Preference:

For goods and works where the requirements are not divisible in nature

- a) Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid will be termed as L1. If L1 is 'Class-I local supplier', the contract will be awarded to L1.
- b) If L1 is not 'Class-I local supplier' the lowest bidder among the 'Class -I local supplier', will be invited to match the L1 price subject to Class-I local supplier's quoted price falling within the margin of purchase pr eference i.e. L1+20% band, and the contract shall be awarded to such 'Class-I local supplier' subject to m atching the L1 price.
- c) In case such lowest eligible 'Class-I local supplier' fails to match the L1 price, the 'Class-I local supplier' with the next higher bid within the margin of purchase preference i.e. L1+20% shall be invited to match the L1 price and so on and contract shall be awarded accordingly. In case none of the 'Class-I local supplier' within the margin of purchase preference matches the L1 price, the contract may be awarded to the L1 bidder.
- **(XV) Quantum of LD:-** If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.
