5. 6. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

The Bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify in the Techno Commercial Bid:-

I) PAN: The Bidder should be registered with the Income tax. Relevant proof in support shall be submitted .

II) Goods & Service Tax Registration (GST): The Bidder should be registered with Goods & Service Tax (GST). Relevant proof of registration Certificate shall be submitted.

III) Undertakings:-

- The bidder has to provide the undertaking that "We M/s. **<Name of the firm>** have not been blacklisted by Government of India/Any State Government/PSU/Any reputed Organization in the past".
- The bidder has to provide the undertaking that "We M/s. **<Name of the firm>** agree to withdraw all the deviations, if any, unconditionally and accept all the Terms and conditions of the tender document including the technical specifications."

SCOPE OF WORK: The objective of the Water Audit is to identify the water uses & water saving opportunities and to demonstrate water conservation at India Security Press, Nashik Road, Nashik (Maharashtra). The Water Audit shall be conducted by the Individual Auditors/Institutional Auditors accredited by Rajiv Gandhi National Ground

Water Training and Research Institute (RGNRGWTRI), RAIPUR or National Accreditation Board for Education and Training (NABET), New Delhi or National Water Academy, Pune and A valid Water Auditors Certificate shall be submitted by the Bidders along with the Bid document to this effect. The Water Audit shall be conducted in accordance with the latest guideline issued by Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA), Ministry of Jal Shakti, Govt. of India.

The tentative Scope of work of the water audit includes the following:

1. Water system analysis.
2. Quantification of baseline water map.
3. Monitoring and measurements using pressure and flow meters and various other devices.
4. Quantification of inefficiencies and leaks.
5. Quantification of water quality loads and discharges.
6. Quantification of variability in flows and quality parameters.
7. Strategies for water treatment and reuse or direct use.
8. Development of detailed water circuit diagram and water balance of the whole System.
9. Mapping of water quality requirement to develop 'recycle' and 'reuse' opportunities. Mapping of Water quality requirement at various user areas.
10. Developing water consumption and wastewater generation pattern.
11. Estimating specific water use and conservation potential.
12. Calculation of rainwater harvesting potential for the site and assessment of the existing structures.
13. Evolving water saving opportunities with method of implementing the proposal with Description and figures related to water management schemes.
14. Investment required for water saving schemes and Cost Benefit Analysis etc.

The detailed water audit report shall contain the following:

1. Water consumption and wastewater generation pattern.
2. Specific water uses and conservation.
3. Complete water balance of the facility.
4. Water saving opportunities.
5. Method of implementing the proposals with description and figures related to water management schemes.
6. Full description and figures
7. Investment required for water saving schemes/Cost Benefit Analysis.
8. Assessment of existing water sources and actual water consumption of the Plant.
9. Identify the loss of water if any during transit and water distribution network and provide suggestion to eliminate these water losses.
10. Identify the opportunities to reduce the water consumption by various activities and to establish specific water consumption in the premises.
11. To study the performance of existing water circulating pumps/motors and recommend energy and water fixtures.
12. Assessment of adequacy and efficacy of existing treatment system and recommend feasible technological option for treatment of water and waste water.
13. To analyze areas of water conservation, waste water generation and recycle.
14. Preparation of detailed water balance schematic diagram.
15. Evolve techno-economic feasible solutions for recommended measure for implementation along with annual financial savings/payback periods etc.

Police Verification Report (PVR): PVR along with Aadhaar card/Voters ID card/Driving License/Passport of the water auditors and his representatives will be required for making entry permission to enter in the ISP Factory to execute the water audit. PVR is compulsorily required for making entry permission for more than one week.

Safety and Security: The water auditors and his representatives shall abide by the

safety and security norms of ISP. Protective Gear such as Safety Helmets, Safety Shoes and Hand Gloves etc. shall be provided by the contractor firm/agency at his own cost to all his Auditors at site.

Responsibility of the contractor firm/agency: Contractor has to arrange all the required materials, tools, tackles, labour, transportation boarding, lodging etc. at his own cost for conducting water audit at India Security Press, Nashik Road, Maharashtra. The Contractor shall be responsible for any damage caused by their representatives to the existing system/property of ISP, Nashik Road and Contractor shall have to compensate the damage caused by their representatives.

V) Payment Terms: 100% of payment shall be released within 30 days after successful completion of water audit, submission of one soft copy & One Hard signed copy of Water Audit Report along with the original Tax Invoice.

VI) Quantum of LD: If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

VII) Delivery Period: Successful bidder has to complete the entire work as per scope of work within 60 days from date of issue of Contract.

IX) Clarification of Bids/Shortfall Documents:

During the evaluation and comparison of bids, the purchaser may, at his discretion, ask the bidder for clarifications on the bid. The request for clarification shall be sought only once on GeM portal, asking the bidder to respond by a specified date/period (**i.e. three days**). If the bidder does not comply or respond by the date/period (**i.e. within three days**), his tender will be liable to be rejected.

Depending on the outcome, such bids are to be ignored or considered further. No post-bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained.

Note: While submitting the Clarification/Shortfall Document any technical difficulty occurs on GeM portal, then the bidder can submit the Clarification / Shortfall Document through e-mail (e-mail id: purchase.isp@pmcil.com).

The Procuring Entity reserves its right to, but without any obligation to do so, seek any shortfall information/ documents only in case of historical documents that pre-existed at the time of the Bid Opening, and which have not undergone change since then and does not grant any undue advantage to any bidder. As far as the submission of documents is concerned regarding qualification criteria, after submission of the bid, only related shortfall documents shall be asked for and considered.

For example, if the bidder has submitted a supply order without its completion/performance certificate, the certificate will be asked for and considered. However, no new supply order shall be asked for to qualify the bidder.

“Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS): By participating in this tender, the suppliers/Vendors/ Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance .

1. “Bidders may please note that GeM is capturing and showing the IP addresses used by the bidder(s). The received bids having matching / common IP address with bidder(s), shall be outrightly rejected & shall not be considered for further evaluation”.

2. “Request for extension of the bid opening date and / or any other query related to bid should be made through GeM portal only, no other means of communication will be entertained”.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
