7. Payment Terms: - A. On monthly basis subject to satisfactory completion of the service and fulfilment of all compliances. B. Settlement of bill for each instalment will be subject to actual and satisfactory completion of the work. The payment (s) shall be made to the contractor after subject to deduction of tax (s) Cess leviable by any Government as per rules from time to time and will be made after the completion of every month on completion of the assigned work and after certification by user department. The bill must be submitted in duplicate. 10.
